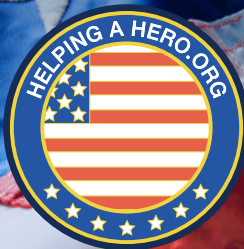

Lee Greenwood

Lee is best known for his CMA Song of the Year from 1985 “God Bless the USA”. Lee is an icon in country music, with more than 30 albums to his credit. Lee has won numerous industry awards including, Male Vocalist of the year for the Academy of Country Music in 1983, two Male Vocalist of the Year awards from the Country Music Association, 1983 & 1984 and a Grammy for Top Male Vocal Performance in 1985 for “I.O.U.”. The song, “God Bless the USA” has been voted the most recognizable patriotic song in America. Lee knows first-hand what it’s like to have loved ones fighting for the freedom of all Americans as his father served in the Navy and the Merchant Marine in World War II. “USA” is now part of the film for Homeland Security shown when swearing in new citizens to the United States.

“God Bless the USA” went far beyond what Greenwood expected when he wrote it in the back of his tour bus in 1983. The song has been in the top five on the country singles charts three times (1991, 2001 and 2003), giving it the distinction of being the only song in any genre of music to achieve that feat. It was also #1 on the pop charts after 9/11/01. Greenwood

says; “USA is the song I always felt the need to write. I wanted to have something that would unite Americans from coast to coast and to instill pride back in the United States. The song represents my family, my community and those men and women who have paid the price for the freedoms we all love and enjoy.” Lee and his wife, Kimberly, a former Miss Tennessee, fell in love on his 1989 USO Tour.

Lee Greenwood has been an ardent supporter of Helping a Hero and has a passion for America, our military, our veterans, and our wounded warriors. In August 2017, Helping a Hero nominated Lee for the prestigious Point of Light award which was awarded by President George H.W. Bush.

Wounded Hero Program

Helping a Hero is building a handicap accessible home in Georgetown, TX for severely wounded warrior, SGT (Ret) James “Shane” Ray, USA. Westin Homes worked with Helping a Hero to design a 4 bedroom, 3 bath home that includes a roll in shower, roll under sink, an adapted toilet area and other safety features. The home is located in MorningStar off Hwy 29 and Kaufman Loop.

SGT Ray received the Bronze Star and Purple Heart during his combat tour in Iraq. Army Sergeant Ray deployed to Iraq with the 101st Airborne, 1/32 CAV RSTA. While on night patrol in June 2006, he was driving a Bradley Fighting Vehicle when it ran over two IEDs, resulting in his injuries including severe burns, the loss of his right leg, and ongoing medical complications. SGT Ray is married and has two children, including one who has special needs. Recently, the family lost their unadapted family home to a fire, it burned to the ground and the family did not have contents’ insurance. Our goal is to raise the funds to fully fund and furnish this home and provide the Ray family everything they need to rebuild their lives in a wheelchair accessible home.

As part of the Wounded Hero Home Program, SGT Ray commits to make the Helping a Hero home his/her primary residence for 10 years, to get a mortgage of \$50,000 and to use the VA Specially Adapted Housing Grant. To date, Helping a Hero has awarded over 100 homes in 22 states and has completed nearby Texas homes in Belton/Killeen, Austin, Round Rock, Bandera, New Braunfels, Canyon Lake, and Robinson.

The Locker is adopting the room for the Ray’s teenage son and outfitting it with a computer, X-Box, desk and everything he needs to hit the ground running for the new school year at Liberty Hill ISD. Marlene McMichael is helping on the color palatte and will help make the home a sanctuary for the family after all the challenges they have faced on and off the battlefield.
